She is currently leading design efforts on AS+GG's modernization and greening of Sears Tower, a role for which she's uniquely suited given her lifelong appreciation for Chicago's architectural tradition and her commitment to sustainability in the built environment.

Born and raised in the Chicago area, Sara is interested in historic preservation and engineering, and has a special fascination with the design of tall buildings. Among her current projects at AS+GG is a supertall hotel tower for a confidential development in Dubai.

Before joining AS+GG in 2007, Sara was a studio head and technical coordinator at the Chicago office of Skidmore, Owings & Merrill. There she collaborated with Adrian Smith on the design of the Trump International Hotel & Tower in Chicago, and was also involved in the renovation of Mies van der Rohe's Dirksen Federal Building.

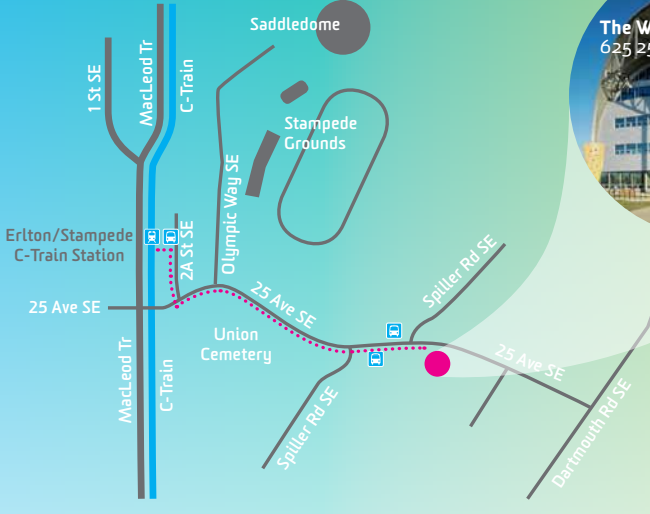
